BACKGROUND:

January 12, 1988	The first-ever Florida Lottery game, MILLIONAIRE, debuts; first-week sales of the \$1 Scratch-Off game top \$95 million.
September 27, 1993	The Lottery launches its first \$2 Scratch-Off game, BINGO.
March 3, 1998	The first \$3 Scratch-Off game WIN A MILLION launches.
November 9, 1998	12 WAYS TO CELEBRATE, the first \$5 game goes on sale.
August 20, 2002	The Lottery debuts its first \$10 game, CASH BONANZA.
June 29, 2004	GOLD RUSH, the first \$20 Scratch-Off game is launched, and produces \$3.7 million in its first week of sales.
January 23, 2007	MILLION DOLLAR MONOPOLY, the first Scratch-Off game to offer a \$1 million prize, debuts. Ten days later, 90-year-old Myrna Fonda claims the first top prize.
January 22, 2008	The Lottery celebrates its 20 th anniversary with its first \$30 Scratch-Off game, \$600 MILLION HIGH ROLLER.
April 1, 2008	Players can now enter eligible non-winning Scratch-Off tickets in to drawings on the Lottery's website, starting with the CASH BLOWOUT Second Chance Drawing.
February 24, 2009	The Lottery launches BILLION DOLLAR BLOCKBUSTER, offering an unprecedented \$1 billion in total prizes.
September 25, 2013	The Lottery celebrates its 25th anniversary with its first \$25 Scratch-Off ticket MILLIONAIRE, offering the highest prize payout percentage ever in Florida Lottery history.
